Dear dog owner,

Your dog is a welcome guest. Nevertheless, here are a few pointers for harmonious co-existence of man, dog and hotel!

Dogs need to be:

- Well-behaved and house-trained
- Agreeable (no biting or incessant barking)
- Covered by third party liability insurance

At the hotel:

Dogs must be kept on the lead in all areas of the hotel as there may be other dogs in the hotel, and some guests may be afraid of your canine companion.

Our reception staff will be delighted to provide you with dog walking route information.

In your room:

Please bring your own dog bed and/or blanket. If you leave your dog unattended in the room, please inform reception and hang the 'Do not disturb' sign on your door. We can only clean your room when your dog is not in it. Please arrange a suitable time with reception.

Dogs are not allowed on beds or upholstered furniture!

Should your dog soil the room or cause damage to furniture, doors, carpets etc., we will charge you for cleaning and/or repair costs.

Dogs are not allowed in our main restaurant. However, your dog is welcome to join you in the Jagastub'n for dinner, so long as you let us know in advance, and he or she remains quietly under your table.

For reasons of hygiene, dogs are not permitted in any wellbeing and sauna area.
